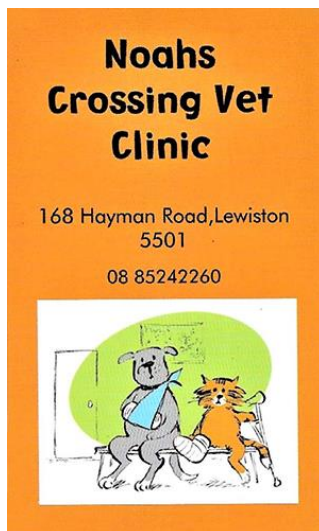
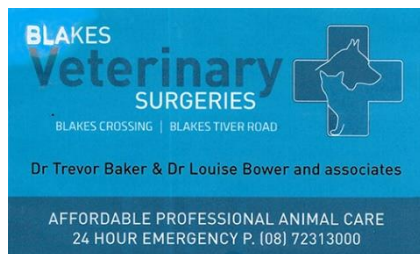

SHOW RING ETIQUETTE

Pick up any bait you drop or toss

Pay attention to the judge's directions

Leave plenty of room for the person in front of you

Use squeaker toys only when it won't disturb other dogs

Be ready to go into the ring on time

Ask if others are ready if you are first in line

Let the judge and others know if your bitch is in season

Only feed your dog when the judge is past looking at the head and
bite

Be sure the steward and judge can see your armband

Make sure your dog(s) is quiet and contained at ringside

Be polite to other exhibitors, the judge and ring steward

Congratulate the winners

Additionally,

Talking to your dog in the ring is okay

Starting over is okay

Taking your time to present your dog well is okay

Asking for more space is okay

Making sure you aren't blocked by the table, ramp or poles is okay

Having fun is okay

The British Bulldog Club of South Australia Inc. – The Beginnings

The British Bulldog Club of SA Inc is one of, if not the oldest, single Breed Clubs in Australia. Its beginnings go right back to 1906. Check out the Club website for more early history.

I hear that a movement is afoot to form a bulldog club, and that the matter is being taken up with much enthusiasm. We are sadly in need of some specialist clubs in the interest of various sections of the 'friend of man.' On numerous occasions 'Breeder' has urged this, and now welcomes the news. Full particulars are not to hand, but when it is remembered that we have so widely known a breeder as Mr. Nash among us, it is not surprising that something is doing among bulldogs. Mr. Nash owns Taraxacum, the beautiful golden brindle I described about a year ago, probably one of the best headed dogs living. The other day Mr. F. W. Marshall showed me a fine brindled bull puppy, and I noted he had a much deeper head than usual, and strongly reminded me of a head I had seen somewhere. It turned out the puppy is a son of Taraxacum, and promises to turn out well, great bone and good style all round. A bulldog club with monthly or quarterly meetings whereat exhibits are discussed and papers, &c, read, will boom the breed well. Bulldogs are most satisfactory animals to keep, for they are very faithful and splendid companions, and as a rule not at all mischievous. (*Chronicle Sat 24 November 1906 – THE KENNEL by Breeder*)

At a meeting held at Mr. J. Creswell's office, Waymouth Street, on Tuesday, it was decided to form a bulldog club. Messrs A. E. Stafford, J. H. Potter, O. Gribble, J. H. Ward, W. Perry; A. F. Nash, and F. W. Marshall were present. It was resolved to ask Mr. C. H. Angas to accept the office of president. Mr. F. W. Marshall was elected chairman, and Mr. A. F. Nash hon. secretary, and Mr. J. H. Ward hon. treasurer. It was decided to call the club the South Australian Bulldog Club. The chairman explained the objects of the club, to be the encouragement of the breed and the appointment of approved judges at the leading shows. (*The Advertiser Wed 28 November 1906*)

The announcement that a Bulldog Club has been formed in Adelaide will be received with pleasure not only by the lovers of that truly British breed, but also by the many who wish to see the canine section of our shows in, a healthier condition. Although the owners of Bulldogs are few in number, still they compare favourably with owners of most breeds, for even if not so numerous as Collie, Irish, or Fox-terrier owners, the Bulldog people are all sportsmen and exhibit their dogs, not merely to win money prizes or trophies, but from the sportsman's feeling alone. In the president, Mr. Marshall, we have a well-known hard worker and keen fancier in the dog and poultry world. Mr. Marshall at one time owned Croydon Girlie, and a dog whose registered name has just escaped my memory. The bitch I always fancied and considered a really good one. She won here, and recently carried all before her in the West. There are several ardent fanciers of the breed among the members, of whom I shall have more to say later on. In Mr. A. F. Nash, the secretary, the club is fortunate, for it is not often that one meets a Bulldog breeder who has won leading honours in England, America, and Australia. Without in any way wishing to appear as if sitting in judgment, it has been my frequently expressed opinion that it has been a misfortune that among South Australians, until quite recently, there were only a few qualified to judge our shows. Now that we have a breeder of such long experience among the best Bulldogs in the world, he will be a tower of strength to young fanciers and others, and thus the standard of the club should be a high one. (*Chronicle Sat 22 December 1906*)

BREEDING YOUR BRITISH BULLDOG – R.F.G.

RESPIRATORY FUNCTION GRADING



Breathing is assessed via a stethoscope while the dog is calm and relaxed
 The dog's nostrils are assessed.
 The overall body condition of the dog is rated
 The vet will complete a questionnaire on the general wellbeing of your dog



The dog is trotted at 5-6 km/hour for 3 minutes



At the end of the 3 minutes, the vet then reassesses the dog's breathing looking for:-
 * increased respiratory effort
 * Increased respiratory noise
 * recovery time

A GRADING FROM 0-3 WILL BE GIVEN

Types of Dog Shows

A Championship Show is an exhibition for registered dogs at which best of breed and challenge certificates are awarded. A best of breed and challenge certificate evidence the number of points awarded at the fixture towards the title of Australian champion. At these shows only qualified judges officiate.

An Open Show is an exhibition of registered dogs at which no best of breed or challenge points are awarded, but dogs which have been awarded the title of Australian Champion may compete. At these shows, trainee judges officiate, and it is considered the training ground for all young dogs and owners. It is particularly good to help socialise your dog as you may show your puppy from the age of three months.

A Parade is defined as the same as an open show except Champion dogs cannot compete.

Fun Days are open to everyone who has or just loves Bulldogs. Activities here are aimed at both the social and the fun side of interacting with your Bulldog. They are also a great place for prospective owners to see the various colours and meet and chat with fellow owners and breeders. The British Bulldog Club of SA Inc hold a minimum of two Fundays a year for their Members and visitors

Nine Things You May Not Know About Bulldogs (By Katherine Ripley)

1. They Get Their Name From the Sport of Bullbaiting

The Bulldog got its name because this type of dog was preferred for the English sport of bullbaiting, which involved tethering a bull to a stake in the ground and encouraging dogs to try to bite the bull's nose. Bulldogs were well-suited for this sport because of their strong, fearless nature. Breeders bred the dogs to have large, powerful heads and loose skin, so that they could recover from an attack and keep fighting.

2. The Breed Almost Became Extinct

The English Parliament outlawed bullbaiting in 1835, leaving the Bulldog with no immediate purpose. Bulldog numbers rapidly declined, but Bulldog lovers didn't want to see the breed die out. Bulldog breeders eliminated the breed's viciousness, breeding them into the Bulldog pets we know and love today.

3. They Aren't Great Swimmers

Of course, not all dog breeds are made to be Olympic-level swimmers, but if you put a Bulldog in the water without a doggie life jacket, he will be in some trouble. Even though he is only 16 inches tall, he can weigh 50 pounds. Their short legs and small hindquarters aren't equipped to keep their dense body afloat and his large head above the water.

4. They Were Known As "The Churchill Dog"

During World War II, the British referred to the Bulldog as "The Churchill Dog." Apparently, Prime Minister Winston Churchill and the English Bulldog both symbolized the courage and strength of England. Churchill himself actually didn't own any Bulldogs, though – he preferred Poodles.

5. Two Presidents Have Owned Bulldogs

Winston Churchill may not have been partial to Bulldogs, but Presidents Warren Harding and Calvin Coolidge each owned one. Harding's Bulldog, "Oh Boy", had the official title of First Dog while he was in office, and Coolidge's was named "Boston Beans."

6. Many Celebrities Have Owned Bulldogs

The Bulldog is one of the most popular dogs in America, so it's no surprise that many celebrities have them. To name a few, you can look at the Jolie-Pitt family's Bulldog, "Jacques," or the Beckham family's dog, "Coco." Michael Phelps has a Bulldog named "Herman," and Criminal Minds actor Shemar Moore has two Bulldogs, "Shug" and "Moe."

7. The Bulldog Is the Most Popular Dog Mascot

You probably already know at least one sports team that uses a Bulldog as its mascot. There are 49 universities in the United States have a Bulldog mascot, including Georgetown and Yale. This is a testament to the Bulldog's well-known toughness and courage.

8. Most Bulldog Moms Have C-sections

Because Bulldogs have such large heads, the safest way for a Bulldog to give birth is actually via C-section. About 80% of Bulldog litters are delivered this way, to avoid the risk of a puppy getting stuck in the birth canal.

9. Bulldogs Have Broken Guinness World Records

In 2015, a Bulldog named "Otto" set the world record for the longest human tunnel traveled through by a skateboarding dog. Otto rolled through the legs of 30 people, a delight of the crowd that had gathered to watch him. Otto's owners were actually inspired to get a Bulldog after they saw videos of another Bulldog world-record holder, "Tillman," who was at one time the world's fastest dog skateboarder.

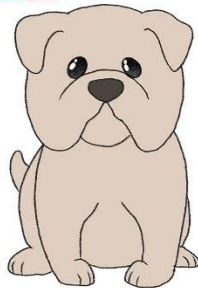
